## • Custom Color Matching (Color sample or Window interior)

**\*NOTE:** Stock pre-finishes are guaranteed ONLY when applied to the wood species they are presented on. Applying a stock stain to a wood species OTHER than the species it is presented on is not guaranteed to match and will LIKELY vary in color from our stock color.

\*NOTE: True beauty comes in the natural variations in wood. Stain and paint finishes can change these natural appearances. Wood species vary from one another in their inherent characteristics. Variations in the grain and material type (solid wood vs. veneers) will impact the overall appearance of the material after finish has been applied. Wood species in all finishes will exhibit color changes when exposed to all types of light. \*Colors shown are as accurate as printing methods will permit; refer to the WDI Color Swatch for accurate color.

**Custom Color Matching:** WDI Co. offers a custom color matching service. Customer's may utilize this offer for matching one of our stock finishes on a wood species OTHER than the species it is presented on or for matching the existing trim in their customer's home.

**Process:** Supply WDI with a color sample on the wood species you'd wish to order. Your sample will be matched and sent/given back to you for confirmation of an "acceptable" color match. Upon confirmation, we will place the respective order into production to be pre-finished using your confirmed color match.

\*Note: Trees are as unique as you and I. Therefore, each tree WILL contain a predetermined amount of grain variation from tree to tree or even branch to branch. Grain variation WILL play a role in the overall finished product. Taking a proactive step in limiting wood grain inconsistency, WDI has implemented a process to pick and choose materials with similar wood grains to be used per order. However, WDI will NOT entertain client complaints regarding grain variation deemed acceptable throughout the Wood Design Industry.
